Horsehead Lake Association (HLA) is a voluntary organization for Horsehead Lake, Big John Brown and Little John Brown Lakes, and was incorporated in 1981 as a private, non-profit corporation. Some of the many services that HLA provides are monitoring invasive weeds and seeing that treatment is conducted in needed areas, maintaining mandated water levels, executing fish surveys and planting walleye fingerlings, periodic water testing, etc. HLA also sponsors recreational activities such as the 4th of July fireworks, the boat parade and the youth fishing tournament. Lake signage and lake event information is another HLA responsibility.

Your welcome support in the form of membership provides property owners with a local organization that looks out for the welfare of Horsehead Lake and the John Brown Lakes. Membership also allows you to communicate your concerns to the Board and to vote at the general membership meeting. HLA puts you in touch with boating safety and lake ecology information and passes on important lake and event information by the newsletter (**The Feedbag**), maintaining a website (**horseheadlake.org.**) and on Facebook (**Horsehead Lake Association**).
